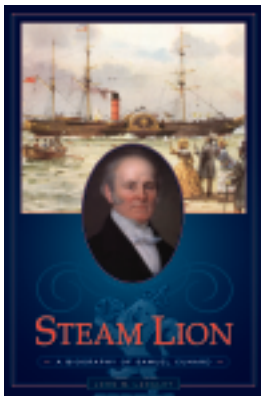


Nimbus Awards Transatlantic Cruise to Bookseller



Albany Books owner Ruth Scowcroft has won a transatlantic cruise for two plus \$500 spending money courtesy of Cunard Cruise Ship Lines and Nimbus Publishing.

Scowcroft participated in a contest to promote the book *Steam Lion: A Biography of Samuel Cunard* by John G. Langley, published by Halifax-based Nimbus in October 2006. The contest, which had ninety entries from across Canada, required each store to create an in-store display for the book. The displays were then judged by the staff at Nimbus.

Samuel Cunard changed the face of international travel when he established his vast shipping empire and became the leading businessman of the period in the Maritime Provinces, bridging the North Atlantic with steam vessels. His legacy lives on today with the Cunard Cruise Lines ships, known for luxury vacations.

Albany Books, in Tsawwassen, British Columbia, is locally owned and operated and has been serving the local community for over 20 years. When she sent in her submission, Scowcroft said, “This has been a great learning experience as well as a good promotion for the book. Even now that the window is gone, people are still coming in to ask for the book based on the window they saw last month.”
